 - o NYSEDA and other OSW Solicitations
 - o BOEM Lease bid credits
- If developers can't get the hard to obtain data to prove they have met job creation promises, they are on the hook for tens of millions of dollars in penalties

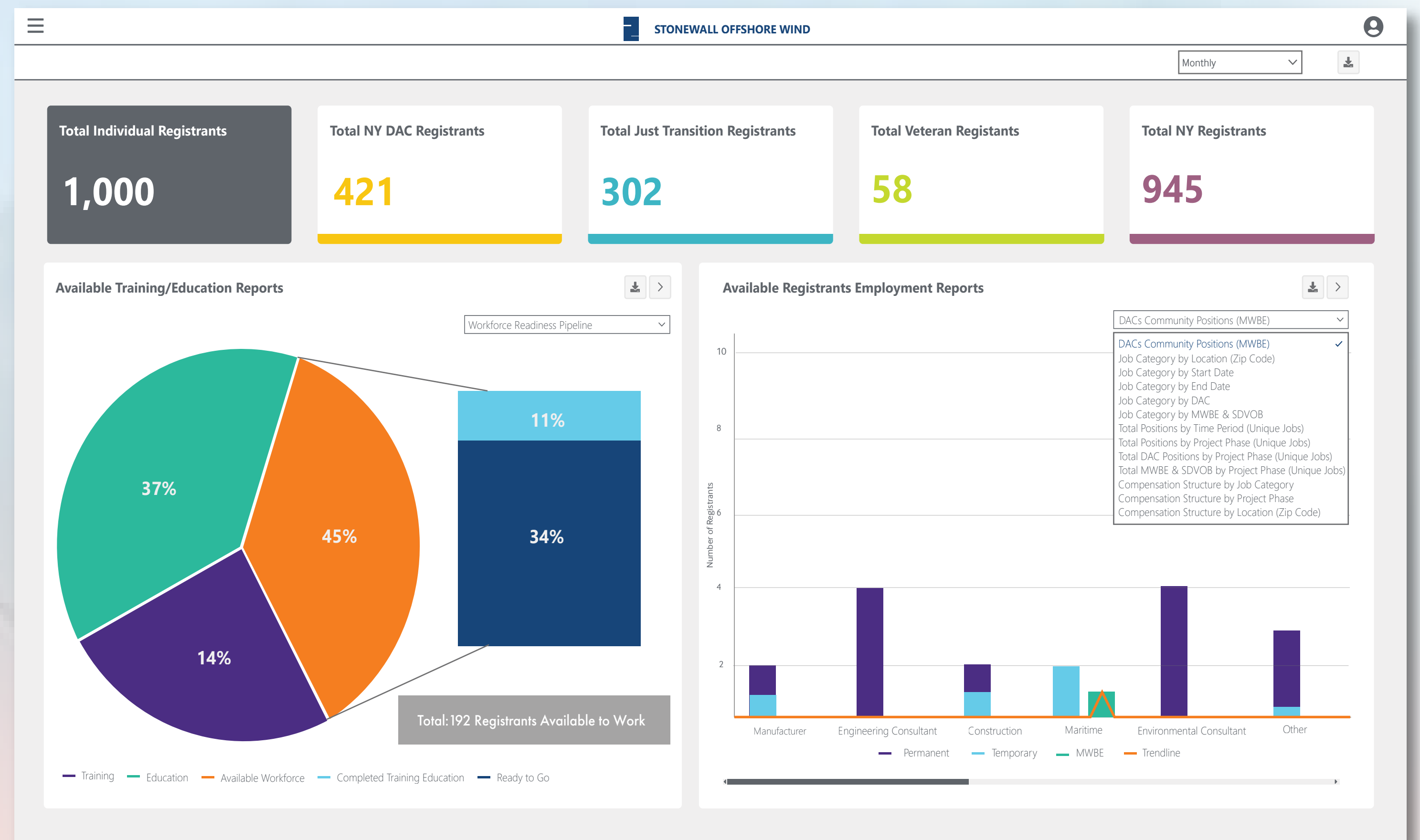
